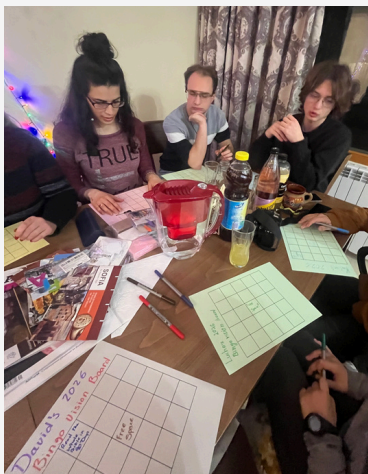


BULGARIA
