- Build a ministry culture that is safe, relational, and spiritually serious, with clear next steps toward Jesus

We value a high-trust team environment where staff are known and know others, pursue discipling in their own lives, protect unity, and welcome coaching.

Job description

This role serves students (typically ages 11–18) and their families through ministry that is both pastoral and missional.

Primary responsibilities include:

- Partner with parents through clear communication, coaching, prayer, and support in key discipleship moments (identity, friendships, dating, technology, anxiety, faith decisions)
- Disciple and shepherd students through relationships, mentoring, spiritual formation, and gospel-centered next steps, including repentance, Jesus' Lordship, and baptism into Christ when ready
- Teach and lead youth gatherings with biblically grounded, age-appropriate teaching for believers and seekers
- Develop volunteer and student leaders through recruiting, training, and coaching, building a healthy leadership pipeline

- Create belonging and connection by strengthening small groups, intergenerational relationships, and transitions (sixth grade entry, graduation, bridges into campus/young adults)
- Outreach and mission by helping students invite friends into gospel conversations and creating accessible on-ramps for unchurched families
- Operate with excellence and safety in collaboration with church staff and leaders (calendar/communication, budget stewardship, child safety standards, and team coordination)
